PARISH COUNCIL MEETING 5th January 2020

- **Councillors in Attendance:** Chairperson Cllr Roberts, Vice-Chairperson Cllr Pearson, Parker, Sharp, Lees, Thomason, Wood.
- **Apologies:** None
- **Also in attendance:** County/Borough Cllr Bell, Parish Clerk, 5 members of the public

Cllr Report & Public Question Time Update

- Cllr Bell & Cllr Lees visited the Traveller Site with 3 PCSO's. Contact details were left with them in order to set up a Liaison group with Borough & Parish Councillors, Police & representatives of the traveler site.
- Cllrs Lees explained that he counted 60+ caravans on site.
- Enforcement know that there are more vans than permitted but it will take time to enforce a move.
- Cllr Bell gave contact details of the Gypsy Liaison officer to the Parish Council.
- Landlord from Malt Shovel still experiencing issues with the travelers using his facilities and threatening behaviour. He says the police are not helping.
- Cllr Bell explained that the land clearance opposite the Quarry is a part of the Quarry not available for blasting but free to use for Quarry activities.
- Police have attended the site and were happy with all paperwork and reports provided. Including a report from Warwickshire Wildlife which approved the work
- A member of the public raised a concern over the gaps left in the new fencing. Told to contact highways if concerned over entrance and exit points.
- Cllr Bell explained that the Quarry owner has been encouraged to set up a Facebook page for Quarry updates.
- Cllr Lees is to meet with Robert Beggs & Sgt Alison Wiggan to speak about funding for a camera on Clock Bridge.
- Member of public interested in starting a litter picking group. Details to be made available to public on how to do this.
- A meeting with the schools is being organised to discuss the current parking situation on Church Road.
