PARISH COUNCIL MEETING 5th November 2019

- **Also in attendance:** County/Borough Cllr Bell & 7 members of the public

Cllr Report & Public Question Time Update

- The final approvals for the health centre have been given. The planning application is now on its way in.
- Warwickshire County Council are holding onto the other 2/3 of the land around the health centre & talks about extra care housing on the site are taking place.
- The HAR 3 application has been deferred again as more information is needed including air quality data and air overpressure data.
- The application for expansion on the gypsy site was refused at the planning meeting on the 4th November.
- A temporary high court injunction is in place with the hope of a permanent injunction by the 7th November.
- Stag & Pheasant pub still experiencing problems from residents of the gypsy site. They felt forced to make a call to 999 following an incident to which no police officer responded. More support is needed for the landlords from police.
- Councillor Lees offered to speak to Sgt Alison Wiggin for more support for the pubs.
- More enforcement is needed on the zig zag lines outside Nathaniel Newton school, people still parking over them.
- The residents meeting arranged for the 28th November is to be moved until after Christmas.
- Lorries travelling over the bridge are to be reported to Cllr Lees along registration numbers & company names if possible. A camera on the bridge is needed to stop the issue.
- Council is still waiting on a date from the Police to take part in their Speedwatch training. Forms were sent in August but still awaiting a date.
- Speeding still a serious problem throughout the village—The Clerk is to write to Traffic Officer of WCC to attend a meeting and discuss the problem.
