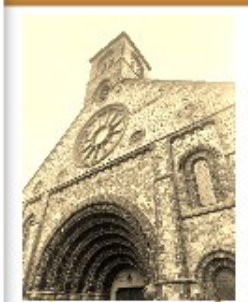

Welcome to the Autumn edition of Hartshill Parish News

Update from Hartshill Parish Council, County & Borough Councillors and Police from recent Parish Council meetings:

- A planning application for the land behind Willow Close has been appealed. All previous objections will automatically go back in and residents of Willow Close are encouraged to provide information on disabilities and the effects the build will have on their health should it be granted. The Parish Council will resubmit their objections too.
- Thank you to Shaan Chaudry for his help in replacing the entry ramp to Links Nursery which was beyond repair.
- Concerns over welfare of horses on traveller site resulted in a visit from the police. Rural Crime are now involved and RSPCA will be visiting the site.
- Hartshill School anticipate a phased opening for year groups after October half term. Site managers from Wates and representatives from the school continue to hold liaison meetings with residents of Church Close to ensure they remain considerate during construction.
- PCSO Emily Jenkins attended the last Parish Council meeting and updated the Council on some crime statistics and the road safety event which took place at Hartshill Hayes and was very well attended.
- Another water leak was discovered outside 40 Castle Road. Severn Trent discovered it to be Fresh Water. A 40ft pipe was replaced on the Park Home site which seems to have stopped the leak at this time.
